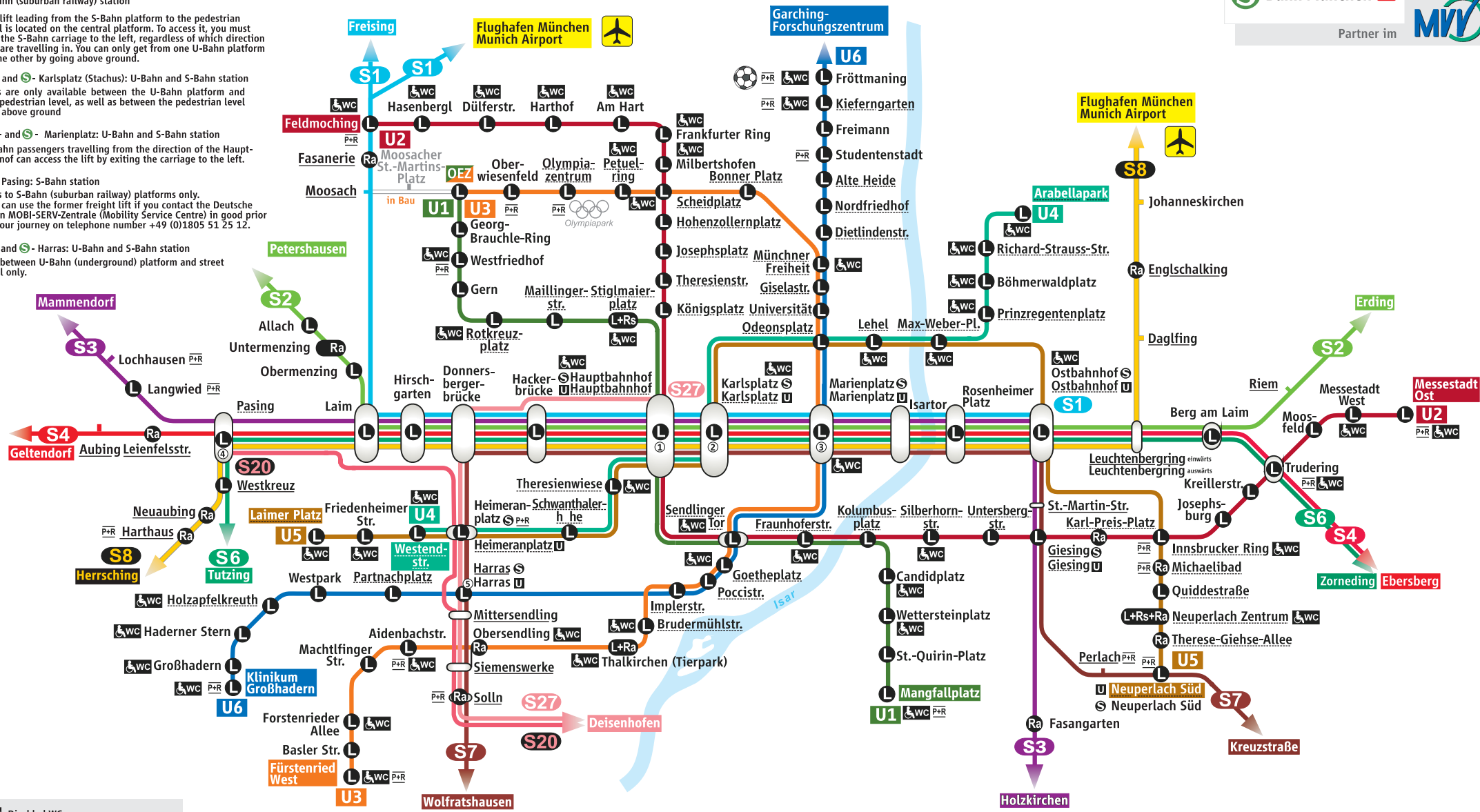




Barrier-free travel with the S-Bahn and U-Bahn (suburban railway and underground) in Munich



- U- and S- Hauptbahnhof: U-Bahn (underground) and S-Bahn (suburban railway) station**
The lift leading from the S-Bahn platform to the pedestrian level is located on the central platform. To access it, you must exit the S-Bahn carriage to the left, regardless of which direction you are travelling in. You can only get from one U-Bahn platform to the other by going above ground.
- U- and S- Karlsplatz (Stachus): U-Bahn and S-Bahn station**
Lifts are only available between the U-Bahn platform and the pedestrian level, as well as between the pedestrian level and above ground.
- U- and S- Marienplatz: U-Bahn and S-Bahn station**
S-Bahn passengers travelling from the direction of the Hauptbahnhof can access the lift by exiting the carriage to the left.
- S- Pasing: S-Bahn station**
Lifts to S-Bahn (suburban railway) platforms only. You can use the former freight lift if you contact the Deutsche Bahn MOBIL-SERV-Zentrale (Mobility Service Centre) in good prior to your journey on telephone number +49 (0)1805 51 25 12.
- U- and S- Harras: U-Bahn and S-Bahn station**
Lift between U-Bahn (underground) platform and street level only.

Details of the height difference between the platform and the floor of the vehicle:

Harthof	Difference in height	2 - 7 cm
Scheidplatz	Difference in height	8 - 13 cm
Westkreuz	Difference in height	24 - 30 cm

The tramways on the following lines have low access heights:
12, 15, 16, 17, 18, 20, 21, 23, 25, 27, N17, N19, N20, N27

Most buses employed on urban bus lines have low access heights and boarding aids.

Which side to exit at S-Bahn stations on the main route:
At the Rosenheimer Platz, Isartor, Hackerbrücke and Hirschgarten stations you exit to the left.
At the Marienplatz, Karlsplatz and Hauptbahnhof stations you exit to the right.
For exceptions to enable you to access lifts, see ①③
No details can be given for the Ostbahnhof, Donnersbergerbrücke, Laim and Pasing stations, due to services being subject to operational changes.

Which side to exit at U-Bahn stations:
Usually, you exit to the left.
At stations on the following lines, you exit to the right.
U1 Kolumbusplatz (heading away from the city centre if not final stop)
U2 Scheidplatz, Hauptbahnhof, Kolumbusplatz (heading away from the city centre), Innsbrucker Ring

U3 Implerstraße
U4 Max-Weber-Platz, Richard-Strauß-Straße
U5 Max-Weber-Platz (heading away from the city centre), Nordfriedhof, Münchner Freiheit, Implerstraße (heading away from the city centre)
U6 Kieferngarten (heading away from the city centre), Nordfriedhof, Münchner Freiheit, Implerstraße (heading away from the city centre)

No details can be given due to services being subject to operational changes.
